### AKRON-KONOPLEV FOOTBALL ACADEMY

Autonomous Nonprofit Organization Akron-Yuri Konoplev Football Academy is a training center located in the City of Tolyatti. This Academy is engaged in attracting and training young football players from all over Russia. The educational institution has at its disposal an indoor arena, pitches with artificial turf, natural grass, an aerobics and gymnastics room, gym, special football training class, as well as medical diagnostics and rehabilitation centers. The Academy has been in operation since 2003.

Over 250 athletes aged 8 to 19, including 30 girls, undergo a sports training course at Akron-Konoplev Academy. Upon reaching the age of 13 the football players have the opportunity not only to participate in the training process but to enroll in a regular school and reside at the premises of the Academy. The 'Academicians' have repeatedly become prize winners and interregional, all-Russian and international tournaments. At the 2018 FIFA World Cup three Academy alumni defended the honor of Russia (Dzagoev, Zobnin, and Kutepov).

Akron has been systematically building a multi-stage system for training football players, at the core of which are children's teams in Zhigulyovsk, Novosemeykino and Tolyatti-based schools. The next step is Akron-Konoplev Academy, which includes teams of the Youth Football League and the Youth Football League. In order to transition to professional football in 2023 the second team Akron-2 was formed; it was assigned to the Second League B. The Academy alumni are among the team players.

JFC PRIDE team released an 8- episode show titled 'Become an MMA Star' on the Federal Sports TV Channel Udar.

A sports camp was set up at Leonid Tyagachev Ski Club with the participation of over 60 athletes aged 12 to 22.

In association with the Russian MMA Union the first visiting all-Russian qualifying MMA tournament was arranged in the City of Smolensk. It was attended by 350 children aged 12 to 16. Akron Fighters team was formed; it comprised participants and winners of the Become MMA Star show, JFC PRIDE winners, as well as a number of young yet active professional athletes.

Long-term contracts have been signed with several promising young MMA fighters.

In 2019, JFC PRIDE was founded.

As of now it is the only MMA promotion company in the world for juniors. The key objective of JFC PRIDE is to identify future stars of the industry at the earliest stages of their career. A complex system of athlete selection was developed with this in mind.

The best of the best – based on the results of such selections – joint the AKRON FIGHTERS team which in turn performs well at professional MMA matches and tournaments.

AKRON FIGHTERS athletes reside at a dedicated training camp which is fully sponsored by Akron industrial holding company.


